



Mt. St. Helens [Lava Dome]

A circular mound that forms from a slow flow of thick lava.

Capulin Volcano [Cinder Cone]

A steep hill of debris from a volcano that accumulates around a vent.

Mt. Fuji [Stratovolcano]

Tall and conical volcano that is built from many layers of lava, ash, and pumice. They are also sometimes called composite volcanoes.

Mauna Kea [Shield]

A volcano built from lava flows.

A cauldron like volcano that forms by land collapsing after an eruption.
